TOWN OF ANDOVER ROAD POSTING

PURSUANT TO TITLE 29-A SECTION 2395, WAYS REQUIRING SPECIAL PROTECTION

The Town of Andover will be posting all town roads to heavy loads this Spring. The postings will begin March 1, 2024, and will continue until May 12, 2024, depending upon the weather.

It will be unlawful for any vehicle exceeding the gross weight of 23,000 pounds to pass over the following designated and posted town ways. <u>UNLESS SOLIDLY FROZEN</u>. A roadway is considered "solidly frozen" only when the temperature is 32 degrees or below and no water is showing in the cracks of the road (if paved) or there is less than ½" of thaw on the gravel surface (if gravel). To be determined only by the Highway Supervisor or his/her designee. Any vehicle exceeding the weight limit traveling during this period must have written permission from the Highway Supervisor or his/her designee unless other arrangements have been made.
