Hobb-Sweat fencing. Dale has been notified that we are going with his quote. He said he would take the contract to Elita at town office. Elita has the contract and we need to pick it up or go there to sign.

New Veteran flags were placed. Poor attendance. Dana and Jane Slayton did Lakeview. Dana & Cheri did Proctor and Old North Cemetery. Bill Keyser did all the smaller ones for us. We need to figure out how to involve more people in helping. Maybe get one of the AEMS school classes to help?

Gravestone cleanup was done on June 3rd with 6 volunteers. There will be 4 other dates scheduled for this cemetery. Will need ladders to reach the top of some of the monuments. Future dates are June 24, July 15, July 24 and August 12. Cheri will put article in the Beacon.

## NEW BUSINESS;

There is a grave in Old North Cemetery where the stone is no longer glued to its base. We will add that to our repairs in the fall.
