He will add a few to the 4th booklet. Jen said she needs them by May 26th. Adam will send what he finds to Jen. He will also help Doug w/vendor set up and told Betty he will donate 4 items to the raffle.

We don't want to burn our sponsors out! Also, Jen gets very stressed as she doesn't hear from "Beacon Steve" in a timely fashion....it's been 9 days since she last emailed him with no reply. He did assure her that he will do the booklet layout, but it is very stressful. It's too late to stop the booklets for this year. We can do paper handouts next year (as we do anyway).

Parade Status: Responses for parade participants are starting to come in. Mike & Michelle will help with the lineup. We agreed to pay \$600 toward the Concord Coach. Rene is working with the 4-H group but no facts yet. Sad news: No Muchachos this year!! They got another engagement that they couldn't turn down; but will come back next year. Donna is looking for another marching band.

Activity on the Green: 22 vendors registered so far. Band is all set. Inflatables all set...three of them: Obstacle course, basketball toss and bounce house (4 way combo).

Recycle containers....haven't located yet. Adam might bring goats and piglets. Still trying to find someone to do the strawberry shortcake as the Catholic Church is not doing. Food: grinders, grilled cheese, fried dough, cotton candy, ice cream (Naughty Nellie), drinks, snow cones....so far. Maybe there will be some breakfast foods (Jane will ask Patty Pond from Proctor).

Program/booklet Status: As previously noted, this is killing Jen! She passed out the ad folders and explained. She needs them back by May 26. Jen will try to get a few of the kids' artwork. Still waiting on Steve. Jane is working on the dedication (the Lebers).

Beacon Articles: We need an article for the June issue. List the library book sale etc. Doug will send a band picture (his band) to Shelley. Adam did a great article for the May issue about the Concord Coach. Jane will do an article about the concert and note there will not be food or drinks sold there.

Fundraising: Betty working on raffle items. Lynn is making progress with sponsorships.

Carr Field: Herbie is planning a corn hole tournament again; it will be next to Closest to the Pin. We are not involved with it at all! No prize \$; maybe a scholarship set up in grandson's name. There will be 3 inflatables (two paid by sponsors): a bounce house 4 way combo or more?, single ax throwing, and 21 foot slide.

Also, Alita has found some glow sticks; Doug brought to show us. We all agreed they will be good. Food: Kev will be doing the Dole Whip. Maybe popcorn.
